The Gas Building Dining Room was established in 1933 and for roughly the last seventy years it has been open at the same location and style . At the time of its opening on the 8th floor of the Osaka Gas Building, the vast view from the windows facing the southeast, and the 'Real

European-Style Dishes' as well attracted many people. Osaka Castle, then having been reconstructed by citizens' donation in 1931, could be seen clearly beyond Midosuji Boulevard.

heating source. As a showcase for kitchens equipped with the latest gas appliances, the Gas Building Dining Room made a strong statement about modern city life and culture brought by city gas.
